# EVENT OVERVIEW

**Event Name:** Hospice Isle of Man's Big Corporate Challenge  
**Date:** Saturday 27th July 2024  
**Location:** Douglas Rugby Club

The Event Team arrives approx. 3 hours before the start of the event to set up the stage, games, PA system, safety signs, barriers, bunting and flags.

Before the battles commence, all teams are put through a safety briefing, and are asked to sign a Code of Conduct declaration form. The event then begins with a fun warm up to music, followed by a demonstration and practice.

The compere announces the start with commentary throughout. There will be around 20 teams of 10 participating.

When all the games are finished the top teams are entered into our Knockout Final, followed by the presentation of medals and trophies.

# THE GAMES



## I'm a Celebrity

Based on the hit ITV show 'I'm a Celebrity', participants dress up in a safari jacket and corked Aussie hat, before clambering through 'The Terminator' assault course towards... 'The Wall of Doom'. In true 'I'm a Celeb' style, contestants need to reach inside the wall of doom to collect a series of critters!! Squeamish beware...



## Beat the Cube

Racing against the clock, contestants clamber over a giant slide before taking aim of the target to successfully release a piece of giant cube. Once the cube pieces are successfully returned, the team have to figure out how to rebuild it....where the fun really begins!



## Teletubby Challenge

You guessed it....Team members dress up as Tinky Winky, Dipsey, Lala and Po before embarking on this challenge. Contestants hoola hoop 5 times before going over the 'Bish-Bash' to collect another hoop. Once off the 'Bish- Bash', the teletubbies race to the hoopla stand to see how many rings they can toss on their coloured marker. The team with the most rings wins.



## Ultimate Relay

In groups of 4, teams walk on planks, inside a modified caterpillar track before undertaking, not a 2 person sack, not even a 3 person sack but yes, you've guessed it - a 4 person sack race! A twist on school sports day and a 'We're a Knockout' classic!



### Rise to the Challenge

A quirky interpretation of the Oxford & Cambridge Boat Race. In this challenge, rather than travel on the water, the water itself is transported by bucket and parachute! The idea is to keep all the water contained as they move along the course. Well that's the theory, the picture tells a very different story...



### Cannon Run

In pairs, teams scramble under a cargo net, through an inflatable wall to begin their mission to find 8 pieces of a disassembled cannon. Once all the pieces are found, there is a head to head race to rebuild the cannon before they (safely) take aim and fire!



### The Foam Pit

Contestants begin the race on tandem space hoppers as they bounce their way through a pit of foam to try and locate their team's ball amongst the sea of bubbles. Once found, the match begins as teams compete to throw the ball into an 8ft high inflatable target! Bring a towel for this one, you'll need it!!
